Impact of Giving.

259 OhioHealth patients were provided transportation, meals and cleaning assistance in 2023. The impact for each patient is simply amazing, as shown below.

- 1,460 rides to and from appointments
- 13,871 healthy and delicious meals provided to patients and their families
- 156 house cleaning services provided

In addition to these services, another 200 patients received gifts cards to assist with food, gas, electric and other needs.
